Multi-Purpose Building Update. The Ministry of Education has completed its part of the multi-purpose building (old swimming pool space). Fire Compliance has been updated too throughout the school connecting us to FENZ. We now await the code of compliance from the Southland District Council. Our next steps are to line the interior walls, install two heat pumps, and the arena fit flooring from Eco Floors. We have everything on site, ready to go, once we get the final approval.

Teachers Only Day. No school on Monday 27th May as we are holding a Ministry-allocated Teachers Only Day as part of our ongoing Professional Development. Our focus is on Health Education and we are starting our school's journey with Mitey, a health and wellbeing programme. Sir John Kirwan has developed this, with it being the most successful well-being learning in New Zealand schools. We are excited about our journey with Belinda Brown (Facilitator).

Cross Country. Next week we continue our preparations for cross country with runs on the track. This will be marked out on paddocks next to the school. The ground is uneven, and wet with mud in places. All students will need to bring a change of clothing and shoes on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday next week for this. They won't be able to do this in school uniform.

Teacher Aide Vacancy

Teacher Aide/Kajāwhina Kajako

We are looking for a teacher aide to join our team.

The role of a teacher aide is to assist teachers in a classroom by working with students on a one-to-one basis, or in groups.

This position has been generated due to a student requiring additional support for health needs.

A teacher aide's work falls under these 3 broad areas;

- General support (classroom/academic) follows classroom programmes
- Additional support (e.g. behavioural, high health or pastoral) supports a child/ren with specific health, behavioural or other needs
- Te Ao Māori acknowledging the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi, and the bicultural foundations of Aotearoa New Zealand, all students should have the opportunity to acquire knowledge of te reo Māori me ōna tikanga developing understanding and knowledge of.

The teacher aide work matrix sets out the most common skills, responsibilities and demands that apply to teacher aides for each grade. The grade a teacher aide is on will determine their pay rate.

This is a fixed-term position from Term 2, Week 4 until Term 4, Week 10 end of 2024, as it is assigned to a specific student. There is a possibility this could be extended into 2025.

Hours from 9.00 am-12.40 pm daily - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

Training and support will be given with the opportunity to get to know our staff and students and to learn alongside our current teacher aides.
